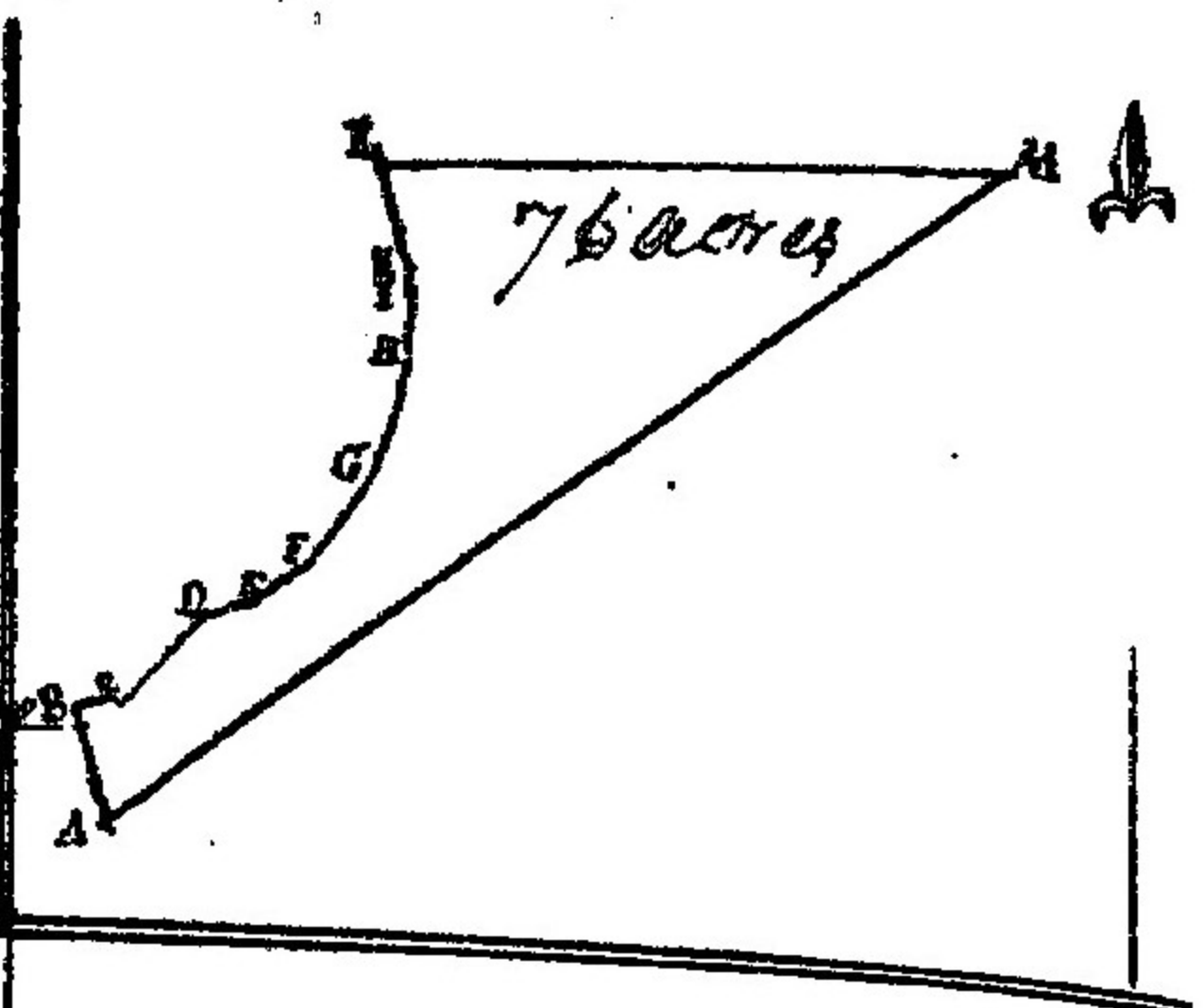


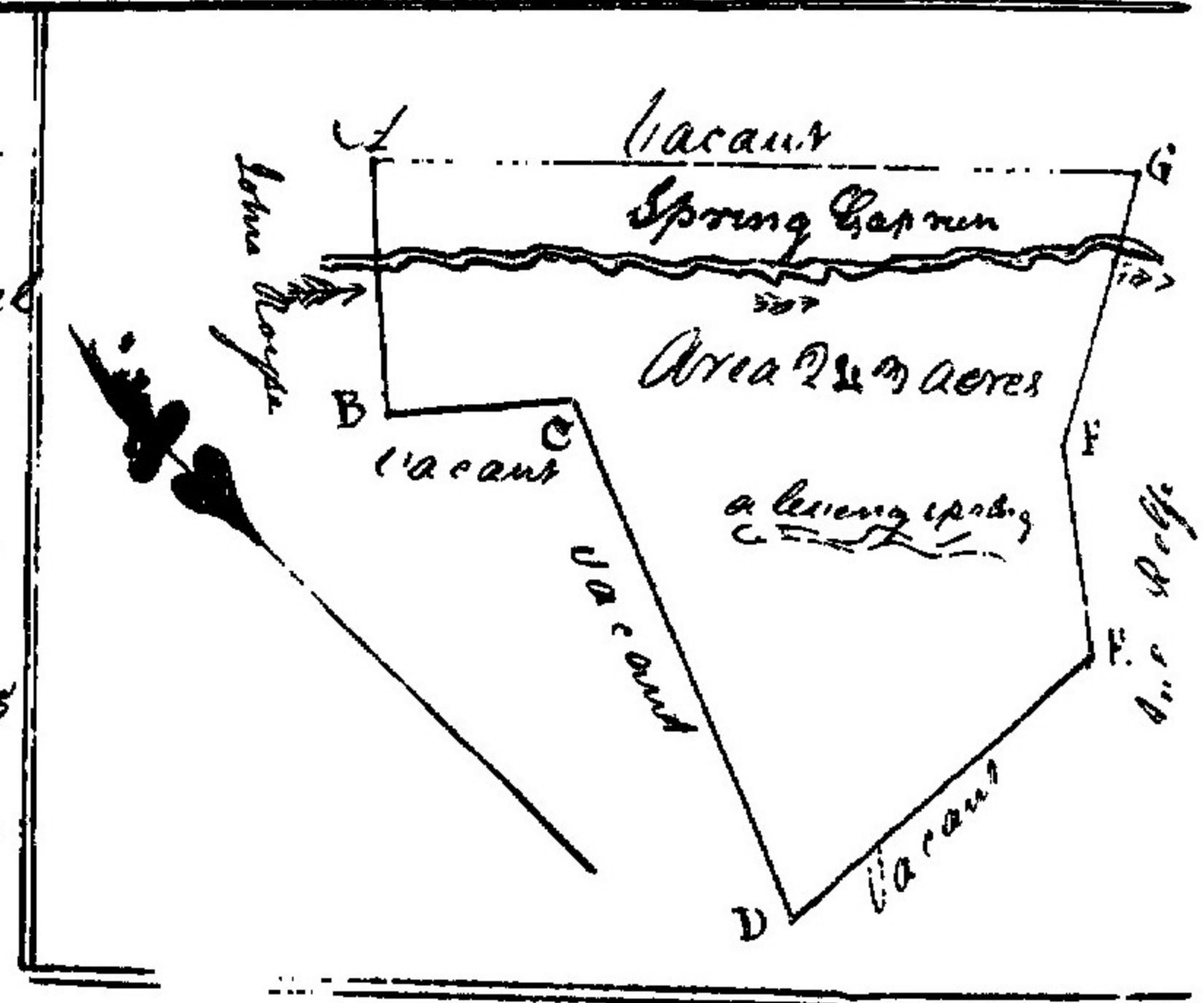

 Corner to Peter Hestants land. Thence down the said river with the several courses
 thereof N 76 1/2 E 10 poles. N 49 E 30 poles. N 78 E 12 poles. N 56 1/2 E 17 poles N 35 1/2
 E 28 poles. N 17 E 30 poles. N 45 E 17 poles. North 6 poles. S 17 W 26 poles to a black
 Walnut tree on the bank of said river a corner to Henry Brumpachs land. Thence with
 his line leaving the river N 87 E 17 1/2 poles to a white oak another of Brumpachs corners
 Thence S 54 W 29 1/2 poles to the Beginning containing 76 Acres -

 Royce's corner white oak & hickory sapling on the south side of a ridge extending
 thence along his line S 98 W 82 poles to B his corner white oak in a hollow by the side
 of a drain. Then leaving said tract East S 52 E 62 poles poles to C a white oak sapling
 on the S. side of a ridge then S 20 W 184 poles to D a hickory and white ^{oak} sapling. Then
 S 85 E 140 poles to E. a pine on the south side of a ridge Then N 35 E 66 poles to
 two large pines corner to Thos. Trepletts 191 Acre tract (now the property of Mr John
 Relfe of Philadelphia) then along a line of said tract by crossing spring gap run 4 1/2
 E 95 poles to G. seven pines another corner of said survey. Finally N 47 1/2 W 270 poles to
 the beginning, containing 243 Acres - Executed December 6th 1765
